Description of the Firm

St. Charles Capital is one of the fastest-growing national boutique investment banking firms in the U.S., located in lower downtown Denver. St. Charles provides financial advisory services related to sell-side and buy-side mergers and acquisitions, recapitalizations, private placements of debt and equity, fairness opinions, and general financial advisory services. The primary target market for St. Charles is companies with revenues between \$10 and \$200 million. Collectively, the partners of St. Charles have completed over 200 transactions valued in excess of \$7 billion in total consideration both nationally and internationally. The firm is organized around four industry verticals:

Intern Candidates

We recruit highly motivated individuals with distinguished academic performance for the summer intern position who have a top tier educational background in business — typically economics, finance and/or accounting, and who have a strong interest in pursuing investment banking as a career at the completion of their undergraduate degree. We also recruit individuals with exceptional backgrounds outside of business that have demonstrated an ability to understand and work with financial statements. The intern position is 10-12 weeks in duration during the summer prior to the student's final year of undergraduate education. Compensation and benefits are provided with the expectation that interns will work as needed. Exemplary interns may receive an offer for full time employment as an Analyst.

Primary responsibilities for this position include working closely with the Analysts and Associates on transaction execution (i.e. financial modeling, industry research, and the preparation of pitchbook and management presentations). Most transaction teams include three to four team members allowing our interns to work closely with senior members of the team. Candidates should be able to demonstrate the following: an outstanding academic record; leadership in academic, athletic, or extracurricular activities; relevant course experience; consistent attention to detail; a good natured work ethic; and possess exceptional quantitative, analytical, written and oral communication skills.
